OUR LADY, HELP OF CHRISTIANS



The feast of Our Lady, Help of Christians is celebrated today (**Tuesday, 24th May**). This feast day has been celebrated in Australia since 1844. The early Church in Australia had a special reason for turning to Mary. In those early and mostly priestless days, it was largely the rosary that kept the faith alive. Catholic Australia remained faithful to Mary, and was the first nation to choose her, under the title of Help of Christians, as Patroness of Australia.

SHPPS CROSS COUNTRY CARNIVAL
